
#### **MAPLES AIRPORT OPERATIONAL OVERVIEW**

1<sup>st</sup> GA airport in Florida to partner with the Blue Lightning Initiative to end human trafficking.



Nationally recognized noise abatement program



Created the Fly Safe, Fly Quiet (FSFQ) program, centered around a voluntary curfew aimed at reducing noise during nighttime hours of 10pm-7am.



Launched FSFQ Leaderboard in Jan. 2024 to recognize top operators



\$10 million invested in noise abatement efforts since 2000



98.7% voluntary nighttime curfew compliance



Purchase and deployment of portable Noise Monitors

#### **PART 150 NOISE STUDY**





Submitted to the FAA in June 2023

Still waiting for FAA to formally receive the study, at which time they will have 180 days to review



**PART 150 NOISE STUDY – FLIGHT PROCEDURES** 



Engaged 2 consulting firms to design the flight procedures identified in the Part 150



Approved procedures then will be implemented quickly vs. waiting for FAA development



Procedures in development:

- Modify 2,000' hold down ("higher faster")
- Arrival and departure procedures for jets
- Procedures to increase glide slope



**AIRPORT EXPLORATORY STUDY** 

Why? Noise issues, storm vulnerability, and evolving needs of a growing community



This question has been asked at least since 1971



Study is expected to be completed in late spring 2024




Incorporating public input and financial estimates


